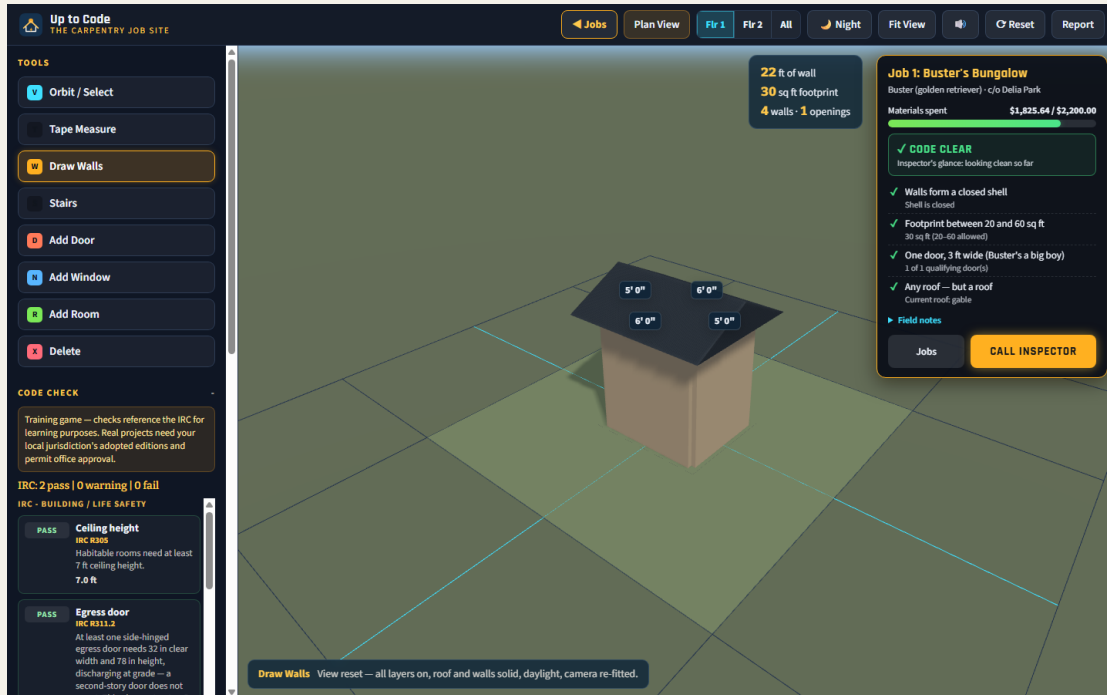


Build to the brief.

A construction career game about specifications, choices and the cost of getting them right.



The real Windows release rendering a completed tutorial shell. The release check loaded a reference plan through the game engine; this is not concept art.

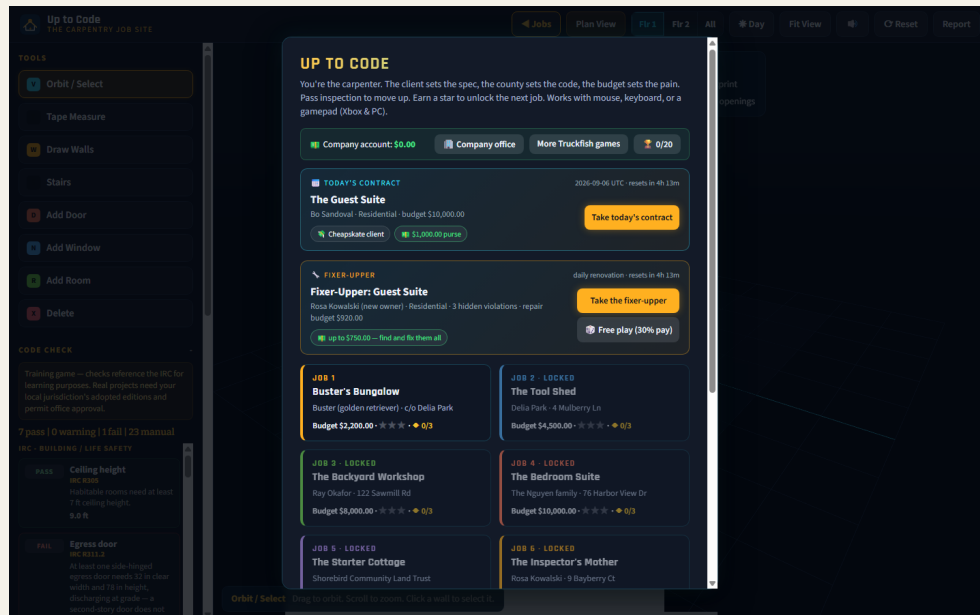
You are the carpenter. Each client asks for a building, gives you a materials budget, and expects it to pass inspection. Draw the structure in 3D, compare it with the contract, and turn the inspector's findings into your next improvement.

The career starts with Buster's Bungalow and grows into residential and commercial jobs. Earn at least one star on a job to unlock the next. A missed contract requirement or red code item fails the inspection, even when the total score looks good.

This is a game inspired by construction rules. Its simplified checks are not construction plans, professional design advice, or approval to build.

Your first job

Install, choose a contract, and learn the tools on a small build.



The job board holds the eleven-job career, daily work, renovation jobs, company upgrades and the permanent Truckfish catalogue link.

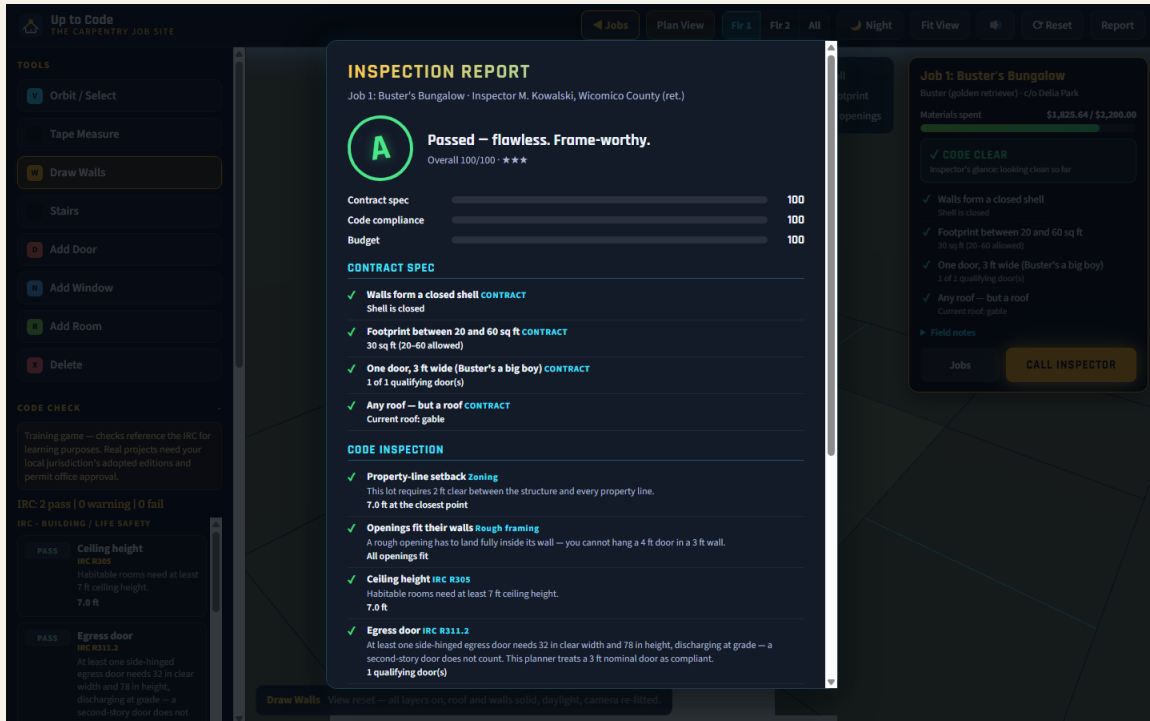
Run UpToCode-Setup-1.2.1.exe on Windows, then open Up to Code. The brief publisher screen closes automatically or with Continue. Choose Buster's Bungalow, read the requested shell, door, roof and budget, then start. The core game and bundled media work without an internet connection.

Mouse and keyboard: W draws walls; D adds doors; N adds windows; R places room markers. V returns to Orbit / Select, T selects the tape measure, and X selects Delete. Esc finishes a wall run or closes a dialog. Use the visible tools, Plan / 3D view and Fit View buttons whenever a shortcut is unfamiliar.

Controller support: left stick moves the cursor; A selects/places; B finishes or backs out; X cycles tools. Right stick pans, the D-pad navigates menus or zooms the canvas, LB changes view and RB calls the inspector. Y passes the hammer in co-op. A physical controller was not used for this release check.

Call the inspector

The report tells you what is wrong and what to repair.



The actual inspector graded the completed tutorial A. An incomplete-shell regression was also rejected during release verification.

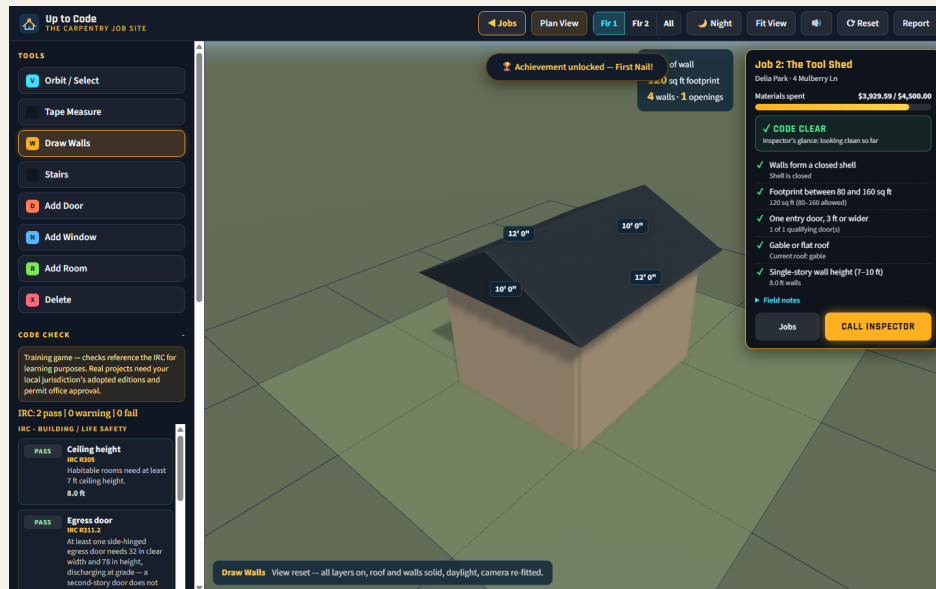
Keep the contract panel in view while building. Close the shell, include the required openings and rooms, and watch the materials budget. Your inspection combines contract specification, code checks and budget; co-op also includes time. A grade C or better passes. Scores of 70, 85 and 95 earn one, two and three stars.

Use the report's failed items to guide repairs, then inspect again. The grade is not permission to ignore a red item: a missed specification or red code result fails the job regardless of the score. Earned stars unlock later contracts.

First steps: build the outer shell before partitions, place openings deliberately, and use Fit View after changing the plan. If a scene appears empty, try Reset > Show everything before clearing your work.

Keep building

Career progress, replay modes and coming back to your work.



The shed follows the tutorial. Later contracts add room requirements, larger plans and tighter design tradeoffs.

Your progress, options and current plan save locally. Jobs returns to the board; reopening the current job can keep your build while changing options. Reset offers view repair, clearing the current build, or erasing all game progress. Read the confirmation before using the last option.

Daily contracts offer repeatable challenges. Renovation starts with a walkthrough: identify violations, then repair and inspect. Optional electrical, plumbing and HVAC systems add equipment and checks. Local co-op shares the hammer between two to four players with separate wallets. Company earnings buy permanent upgrades, and achievements record milestones.
